



















# BULLDOG HITCHLOCK HITCH IDENTIFICATION CHART

All reference numbers are corresponding to the hitch head not the draw bar plate.

\* NOTE: If the GA3500 is fitted with a 'cappit' on the front hitch bolt the Hitchlock will not fit.

**NOTE:** Some Bradley hitch heads are fitted with excessively long fixing bolts. These may need cutting to within two threads of the lock nuts.
